The Ayancık Akgöl lake lies on a plateau of 1200m hight in the Black Sea region, 95km away from Sinop. It is a paradise with rich flora, fauna and endemic flora amidst the endless pine forests. The Inaltı Cave on the plateau (1070m above sea level) provides a high, wide and elongated cavity world, which is rich in stalactites and stalagmites. It's length is 750m, width 6m and hight 30m.

The inhalation in the cave has a good impact on asthma patients.

Along the way you will see the first plant of Turkey for wood materials industry built by Germans and Belgians in 1926, now out of service, then the most modern plant Europe's in wood industry. You can still see only one of the last 70 m high rope mast of the 200 masts of that time on 40 kilometer cable car route for the transport of wood to the plant in Ayancık.

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
